## **Current and Upcoming Events:**

  began the Live FSA assessments.
- Our Learning Support Services team is finishing up IEPs (Individual Education Plans) this week with students and families who have a child with a Ministry designation to support their neurodiversity or diverse needs.
- Friday, October 25, 2024, is a Professional Development Day across the province. Teachers attend conferences at a variety of sites or collaborate on their professional growth plan learning. Education Assistants will attend a large conference at Moscrop that is specifically geared to the requirements of their job.
